RV Friendly Town - Booleroo Centre

In collaboration with the Booleroo Centre Recreation Grounds, Council recently signed a letter of understanding with the Campervan and Motorhome Club of Australia (CMCA) to officially declare Booleroo Centre as an RV Friendly Town.

The Booleroo Centre RV Park is now recognised through the CMCA network as a place providing amenities suitable to the campervan and motorhome audience such as general shopping, suitable and low cost parking and access to potable water and free dump point.

Being an RV Friendly Town provides the opportunity to promote the region's attractions and capture a part of the tourism growth market.
