Pine Creek Bridge

The District Council of Mount Remarkable is formally requesting information from neighbouring Council, Northern Areas Council, in relation to the Pine Creek Bridge.

At the Council meeting held on 20 April 2021, Council resolved to formally request Northern Areas Council to share information relating to the Pine Creek Bridge to enable Council to see how it can partner with Northern Areas Council, to ultimately achieve an outcome on this ongoing issue.

“Whilst this bridge is not in our Council area, we certainly understand the importance of this bridge to the wider area. It is an integral freight route, and our area is made up of a large number of primary producers. We owe it to them and our communities to work with anyone who is willing to get an outcome on this bridge” said Mayor Phillip Heaslip.

Council will formally write to Northern Areas Council seeking copies of all current information which will hopefully include engineering assessments, and detailed costing options for repairs and or replacement.

Council is also considering the Pine Creek Bridge forming part of Council's draft 2022 State election strategy.
