Design and Reconstruction of Port Germein Road Bridge, Port Germein	The project involves the design and reconstruction of Port Germein Road Bridge. It consists of strengthening the existing bridge elements, including steel beams, while maintaining the current superstructure and substructure.	\$1,488,646\$	\$1,860,808

CEO Sam Johnson welcomes the funding received which will allow for works in the district and enhance access and improve freight transport through local communities.

"These projects will support local communities and holiday makers to travel in greater safety, and assist businesses to deliver and receive their products and services more efficiently" he said.
