Just a reminder regarding the use of roundabouts

Approaching a roundabout; drivers must give way to any vehicles already in the roundabout. The driver must slow down and if necessary, stop to avoid a collision and only enter when there is a safe gap.

Going Left

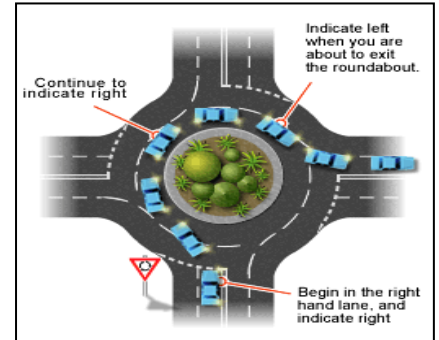
1. On approach you must be in the left lane, and indicate a left turn.
2. Enter the roundabout when there is a safe gap in the traffic.
3. Stay in the left lane.
4. Keep your left indicator on until you have exited the roundabout.

Going right

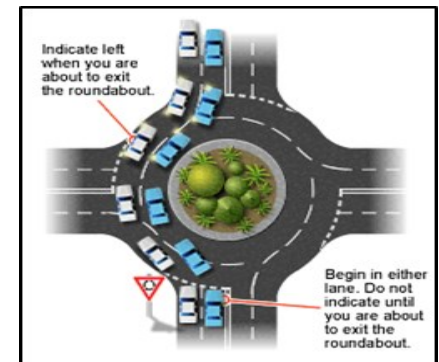
1. On approach you must be in the right lane and indicate a right turn.
2. Enter the roundabout when there is a safe gap in the traffic.
3. Stay in the right lane.
4. You must indicate a left turn just before your exit unless it is not practical to do so.

Going straight ahead

1. On approach you can be in either lane, unless otherwise marked on road.
2. When going straight ahead you do not need to indicate on approach.
3. You must indicate a left turn just before you exit unless it is not practical to do so.
