



4. Workers compensation claim – .....

Council resolved:

*“That the Council, having considered this matter in confidence pursuant to section 90(2) and (3)(h) of the Local Government Act 1999, now resolves, pursuant to Section 91(7) & (9) of the Act, that all documents and discussions relating to Item 14.1.4 remain confidential for a period of two (2) years from the date of this Meeting or until such time as the matters have been finalised and any restrictions on the release of information are satisfied, and that this Order be reviewed at least once in every year during the period of confidentiality”.*

As stated, it is a requirement that Council must review Confidential Orders every twelve months and decide if it wishes the matter to remain in confidence or be revoked.

The Chief Executive Officer will give a verbal update on information received on this matter.

**That** Council, having considered this matter in confidence pursuant to section 90(2) and (3)(h) of the Local Government Act 1999, now resolves, pursuant to Section 91(7) & (9) of the Act, that all documents and discussions relating to Item 14.1.10 remain in confidence confidential for a period of *...(to be determined by Council)...* from the date of this Meeting or until such sooner time as the Council determines that there is no continuing requirement to maintain the documents (in whole or in part) in confidence and that this Order be reviewed at least once in every year during the period of confidentiality.
