Resignation – former Willochra Ward Councillor, Lesley Till

The District Council of Mount Remarkable has received the resignation of former Councillor, Ms Lesley Till.

Ms Till was elected to Council at the November 2022 General Election, and has served as Council's Deputy Mayor since December 2022.

Ms Till in her resignation acknowledged Mayor Stephen McCarthy for his guidance and leadership, Council Chief Executive Officer Sam Johnson, and the broader Mount Remarkable Team who she believed "..truly strive in performing their duties to bring Mount Remarkable into the spotlight, not only locally but also globally."

Mayor McCarthy formally acknowledges Ms Till's commitment and service to the community, and has genuinely appreciated her participation in serving the Mount Remarkable community, in particular the residents of the Willochra Ward.

Council has advised the Electoral Commission of South Australia of the vacancy, and received advice that a Supplementary Election will be required. The Electoral Commission will be responsible for the Supplementary Election, and as further updates become available Council will share accordingly.
