

DEFINITIONS

Compensation includes all employee benefits (as defined in AASB 119 Employee Benefits) including employee benefits to which AASB 2 Share-based Payment applies. Employee benefits are all forms of consideration paid, payable or provided by the entity, or on behalf of the entity, in exchange for services rendered to the entity.  - d) One entity is a joint venture of a third entity and the other entity is an associate of the third entity.
 - e) One entity is a post-employment benefit plan for the benefit of the employees of either the reporting entity or an entity related to the reporting entity. If the reporting entity is itself such a plan, the sponsoring employers are also related to the reporting entity.
 - f) The entity is controlled or jointly controlled by a person identified in 1).
 - g) A person identified in 1) above has significant influence over the entity or is a member of the key management personnel of the entity (or of a parent of the entity).
 - h) The entity, or any member of a group of which it is a part, provides key management personnel services to the reporting entity or to the parent of the reporting entity.
